If you owned an Xbox One X or Xbox One S console in the last generation of consoles, you probably know how fantastic the Xbox Game Pass is — but if you're just joining the Xbox Series S and Xbox Series X green team, we'll be the first to say it's probably the best way to launch your game collection on the new console. Xbox Game Pass is like having the ease and convenience of Netflix meeting with a video game rental store you remember as a kid, and the result is an all-you-can-download service that offers over 100 titles that can be downloaded whenever you want and yours to keep as long as you stay signed up for the service. The only problem with the combination is that since there is only 365GB of usable storage, the Xbox Series SSD will be full quickly. We recommend that you pick up some expandable storage - like this memory card from Seagate - to give yourself some extra space for more games. On it, you'll find brand new first-party Xbox games like Gears 5 and Halo Infinite there in the days to launch, as well as classic gems from the original Xbox and Xbox 360 eras. If they weren't enough to choose from already, Microsoft and EA are now offering a full EA Play catalog of games for the service – games like UFC 3, Dragon Age: Inquisition, FIFA 20 and more – at no extra cost. As great as the service, however, can be a bit overwhelming for first time users. The way the service is organized doesn't really help you find the best games or even the most popular. This is more or less just a mish-mash of games all thrown together with the latest additions on top. So instead of forcing you to dig through the catalog yourself, we've compiled a list of the best games to skip from the service. So you know what to look for when you load the service, or if you haven't subscribed yet, what you get if you decide to commit to Microsoft's huge downloadable subscription service. Today's best Xbox Game Pass deals1. Alien Isolation (Image credit: SEGA)There are a lot of places you can start with this list, but few are better than Alien: Isolation, a survival-horror game from Creative Assembly and SEGA that is tasked with surviving an alien-infected ship. If you've always warned horror movie characters who make easily avoidable mistakes that prove fatal, this is your chance to prove you're a better first officer.2 ARK Survival Evolved in Minecraft and Jurassic Park - which sounds amazing even on paper. This is an action adventure survival game that puts you on an island with basically nothing in hand and tasks to build up Basecamp. From there, you'll have to go out and capture the local fauna - everything from dinosaurs and mammals that are downright monsters - and breed them. The only problem? It's all an open-world MMO, and there will be other players to contend with as well.3. Batman: Arkham Knight (Image credit: WB Games)You may have to wait a while for the next Batman movie with Robert Pattinson, but if you need to fix the cloaked crusader before, check out Batman: Arkham Knight on xbox game pass. The final entry in the Rocksteady Batman trilogy also acts as a great standalone title, as does the hood to stop Batman's entire villains gallery from taking over Gotham in what should be the longest night of Batman's career. 4. Doom Eternal (Image credit: id Software)Having Doom Eternal on xbox game pass just proves how great value the service really is. This game came out in March 2020, and in October, it was already in service. Not only is it good that this is a recently released game, but Doom Eternal is actually one of the better shooters released this year. It is fast-fast-fast and frenetic, putting you against the hordes of hell with nothing more than a butt-load of armor and artillery. A great download if the idea is to completely overthrow a demon army.5. Dragon Age: Inquisition(Image credit: EA)Thanks to the recent partnership between EA and Microsoft, players can now receive EA Play games at no extra cost as part of their Xbox Game Pass subscription. While EA Play brings a lot of great new games at download, one that stands above the other is Bioware's ambitious open-world RPG, Dragon Age: Inquisition. It was game of the year back in 2014 when it was released and still considers itself one of the best games of the last generation. If you missed it earlier, now's the time to give it a shot. (Image credit: Bethesda) Unfortunately, you won't find Bethesda's sprawling fantasy epic The Elder Scrolls V: Skyrim on Xbox Game Pass, but you will find the next best thing - The Elder Scrolls Online. The MMO set in the worldTamriel, The Elder Scrolls Online is to choose one of the three factions, adapted to the geographical location of the world. Within the faction you can form guilds to fight each other and your quest to get to the far reaches of Bethesda's sprawling gaming world, all without paying a monthly fee. 7. Forza Horizon 4 (Image credit: Microsoft)Forza has always been the Xbox bread and butter when it comes to racing games, but Forza Horizon 4 really transcends the genre of wide-open English rural environments and changing seasons that change how cars handle the game. Although this game is great as a personal experience, it's even better when your friends play as well as you'll see the divratars appear in tournaments next to you. 8. Gears 5 (Image credit: The Coalition)Xbox Game Pass is one of the best parts of the newly released first-party free startup, such as Gears 5. Not only is this game a fantastic single player story that follows the events of Gears of War 4, but there is one a great multiplayer mode that is available as part of the package as well. 9. Gears Tactics (Image credit: Microsoft)Gears Tactics turns the traditional third-person shooter franchise on its head with an over-the-top, bird's-eye view of the battlefield. Tactics still have you leading Gears against the Kayas invasion, but this time it's all turn-based combat with special soldiers taking on different roles as a sniper, melee unit or doctor. Missions usually follow a similar formula that can drag a little towards the end of the game, but otherwise Gears Tactics is a fun way to dive into the franchise's doctrines without spending hours looking down on the lancer's sights.9. While Halo: The Master Chief Collection (Image credit: 343 Industries)While Gears 5 and Ori are listed as the best Xbox One exclusive games on Xbox Game Pass, Halo: The Master Chief Collection is in very tight third place. If you haven't heard of it, it's basically the Halo universe of discography, filled with Halo: Combat Evolved Anniversary, and the anniversary editions of Halo 2, Halo 3 and Halo 4. The collection includes all of these games, as well as all multiplayer maps. This is basically the best thing that can happen to any Halo fan ever. 10. Kingdom Hearts 3 (Image credit: Square Enix)It took years to finally release, but Kingdom Hearts 3 was worth the wait. The story is a little slow and somewhat twisted by newcomers to the series, but once past the intro you'll find a charming and action-packed adventure that we called the fantastic nature of Final Fantasy with the magical knowledge of Disney worlds that are almost indistinguishable from the films depicted. yes, that's how good it is. Mass Effect 2(Image credit: EA/Bioware)Yes, Mass Effect 2 was released a decade ago, but that doesn't stop it from not only being the best game in the series, but one of the best games of the past decade. With branching story paths, likeable characters that you spend too much time trying to seduce, and fairly deep RPG mechanics that allow you to customize the characters' work in battle, Mass Effect works on many levels. Maybe not the graphics polish something like Mass Effect Andromeda, but a better site and discover it, it's well worth the space on your hard drive.12. Monster Hunter World (Image credit: Capcom) At one time a very niche franchise here in the West, Monster Hunter has finally gotten a comeuppance from the critically acclaimed Monster Hunter World. This RPG franchise for hunting monsters may sound a bit childish, but the fast, frenetic gameplay and gear grind make for highly satisfying gameplay that you can either undertake alone or shared with your company of friends. Either way, you can't go wrong. 13. Ori and Will of the Wisps (Image credit: Microsoft Game Studios)For years, Ori and Blind Forest have been one of my favorite Metroidvania 2D dungeon crawlers on Xbox One – it's heartfelt, beautiful and challenging, and world is simply oozing personality and intrigue. Years later, Moon Studios and Microsoft released Ori and Will of the Wisps, a sequel that adds some new fighting elements like the shard system that allows for more customization of Ori's capabilities, and big boss battles to make it even more memorable and break up the puzzle solution. 14. Outer Wilds (Image credit: Microsoft)What if there are only 22 minutes left? What could you learn during that time, and if you were given another 22 minutes, what would you do with that time? This philosophical dilemma will be put to the test in the action adventure-exploration game Outer Wilds that tasks you by learning as much of the pint-sized universe as you can in 22 minutes. At this point, the sun becomes a supernova, and you have to start all over again—this time just a little smarter and more experienced than you were before.15 The Outer Worlds (Image credit: Obsidian Entertainment)The Outer Worlds developers Obsidian Entertainment takes everything they loved about the Fallout franchise - their humor, writing and arsenal - and brings it to the wider universe. Below is an unusual, satire-rich RPG that gives a lot of fun to the classic Fallout formula we've grown to love. 16. Overcooked 2 (Image credit: Team17 Digital Limited.)If you need a fun multiplayer game with a pinch, pick up Overcooked 2 on your Xbox Game Pass. This cooperative cooking game saddles up with other players to try to operate a restaurant kitchen efficiently, fulfilling orders that come down to customers. It sounds simple, but things are tricky when parts of the kitchen move or are mistakenly random - the finesse and folly of it all, though, is well worth any irritation you may experience. 17. Rage 2(Image credit: Avalanche)Rage 2 wasn't the best received game when it launched in 2019, but it's still a fun (and fast) first-person shooter that's only loosely tied to the 2011 original. What you can expect is a Mad Max-like experience battling wastelanders and super mutants as you make your way through the badlands. 18. Rainbow Six: Siege(Image credit: Ubisoft)Fans of first-person shooters may be disappointed that there are no Call of Duty games on xbox game pass, but between the Battlefield series and Ubisoft's outstanding first-person shooter, Rainbow Six: Siege, there are plenty of other options. What we love most about Siege is that it relies less on twitch skills and more on tactical planning. Where to lay explosives, how to spread corners and when moving between rooms all counts, and it is decisions like those that make the game with a high skill cap. If you're a first-person shooter fan, you won't miss it. (Image credit: Capcom) Resident Evil 7 biohazard is a comeback in the form of the series - a renaissance of survival-horror consoles that we haven't seen since the fourth game of the series back on Nintendo GameCube. It's really, viscerally scary in the best way, and haunted it's so hilariously disgusting that the miracle never goes away. If you have the stomach for horror, you'll love it. 20. Sea of Thieves (Image credit: Rare)Rare's swashbuckling adventure Sea of Thieves allows you to play the role of a pirate sailing the seas in a fantastic world - either alone or as part of a crew of up to four members. It's up to you to decide to focus on trading, treasure hunting or looting the loot of others. This is a great title for those who like to play with others in an open world environment with a Pirate themed twist. 21. Slay the Spire (Picture credit: Mega Crit Games)For strategy fans, Slay's Spire is like Magic: The Gathering meets Spelunky. This rogue-like deck builder has you modifying the deck to work your way to the top of the tower. As you battle your way to the top of the tower you will need to make decisions about which cards to upgrade, which drinks to set, and which relics, each of which can be the difference between life and death in a boss battle. If you like mind-bending card strikers, Slay the Spire is well worth the space. 22. Tekken 7 (Picture credit: Bandai Namco)Although there are several great fighting games on the service, Tekken 7 is easily the most polished of the bunch now that it has been two years to work out the knot. A 3D warrior in a two-decade pedigree, the Tekken franchise is taking some significant steps forward with its tenth entry in the series, which adds fury to arts and power by shattering the mix, leading to tighter, more intense matches between players of varying skill levels.23. Tetris effect: ConnectedAmak at the time, Tetris was a masterpiece. It was the perfect blend of addictive game mechanics, twisting logic, and, at the final level, a test of quick reflexes. But what if Tetris could be more than that? What if it could be an emotional - or even a spiritual - journey? It's the Tetris effect. A twist on the old game that combines beautiful backgrounds, evocating music and increasing speed to get you in the perfect state of flow. The latest version, Connected, adds multiplayer co-operation mode on Xbox Game Pass, so you can bring two to the emotional roller coaster.24 Viva Pinata (Image credit: Microsoft)If you're tired of warzones, explosions and fistcuffs, this relaxed sandbox sim is like a virtual cold pill. This Xbox 360 gem puts you in charge of the pinata garden that you can whip in shape for over a few hours. Every design decision you make brings out a variety of new pinata creatures who will be residents if certain conditions are met. The hunt to capture new creatures make them happy and get them to breed a seriously addicting game loop, and one that is worth experiencing after a full decade of release. 25. The Witcher 3: Wild Hunt (Picture credit: CD Projekt Red)Some have said The Witcher 3: Wild Hunt is the best game of the decade and it's hard not to agree with them. This huge open-world RPG can be a scary because the size and 60+ hours of completion time, but it's an incredible value as it entertains even the most voracious players for a week or two. Two.
